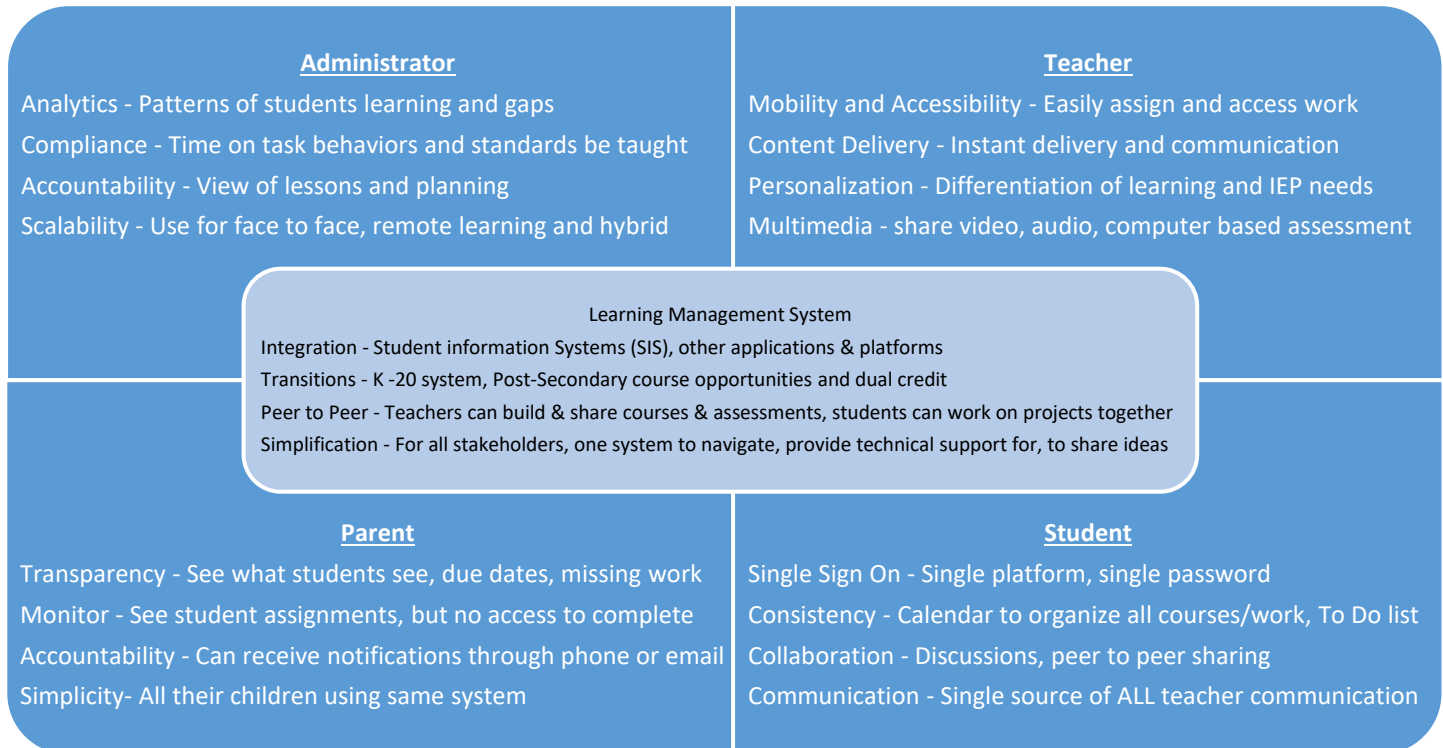


Why a Learning Management System (LMS) is Useful
