



DHHS Update


- Decrease 17 pts (+11,-14,0,+36,+29)
- 7 -day average of 3.3% of staffed hospital beds occupied by Covid Pts (3.4,3.7,4.2,4.2,3.2)
- 29% of COVID pts are in ICU (30;36;24;24;30)
- 29% of COVID pts in ICU are on vents (25;36;41;41;38)
- 10% of statewide ICU pts are COVID pts (11;12;11;14;12)
- Average of 12 COVID pts Admits statewide 1 Day

American Rescue Plan: Renewal and Acceleration

NDE Update

<u>LEA Consultation</u>: LEAs engage in meaningful consultation with stakeholders, including, but not limited to:

- i. students;
- ii. families;
- iii.school and district administrators (including special education administrators); and iv.teachers, principals, school leaders, other educators, school staff, and their unions.

The LEA must also engage in meaningful consultation with each of the following to the extent present in or served by the LEA:

- i. Tribes;
- ii. civil rights organizations (including disability rights organizations); and
- iii. stakeholders representing the interests of children with disabilities, English learners, children experiencing homelessness, children and youth in foster care, migratory students, children who are incarcerated, and other underserved students.

DRAFT TIMELINE:

- NDE is finalizing the timelines and processes as we speak.
- Fast Track Grant (Allocations, Contact Page, Assurances) Coming Soon
- Full Grant (two parts)— July
 - "Safe Return to In-Person Learning Plan"
 - Use of Funds





American Rescue Plan: Renewal and Acceleration

Instructional Hour Affidavit Process

- Flexibilities were provided for additional professional learning and to accommodate extreme weather.
- As noted in "Commissioner's Guidance" documents, districts that do not meet instructional hour requirements still need to complete and submit an affidavit detailing specifics of their case, and outlining all efforts made to reach instructional hour/unit requirements.
- Affidavit will be posted on the NDE's Accreditation webpage, and a Bulletin item will be sent.
- Affidavit will be available by May 17, 2021

Commissioner's Thoughts

- NDE continues to build out supports and resources for this unprecedented allocation of funds.
- Anticipate an update to Launch NE, and a resource guide walking districts through the budgeting, planning, and application process mid-May.
- LHDs will continue to monitor COVID-19 case rates, vaccination rates, and school screening data in their areas.
- Local recommendations will be based on these metrics, current science, and the guidance in current local or state directed health measures (DHMs), when in effect.
- LHDs are working with local schools to help them with summer school and backto-school plans that consider these guidelines and the many unique school environments across the state.
- Stay the course and to continue to follow the safety protocols schools have had in place this year.
